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Individuals who have moles present on some of the parts of their bodies, often opt for mole removal. There are certain moles that exist since the time of birth and there are other few that are formed in the later stage of life as the skin is constantly exposed to the sun. This is because a mole is nothing but a collection of pigmented cells. The ones that are present by birth are known as congenital nevi.

There are a lot of options to choose from for the removal of a mole. Broadly they can be classified as clinical methods and home removal methods. The options that belong to the category of clinical mole removal are also plenty. Having said that, the one that is the most well known is the removal of mole by laser.

This technique basically involves the use of the property of laser to penetrate through things. The power of the laser is not enough to go deep into the skin. As a result of this, moles that are small and flat are removed using this technique. It is not possible to remove bigger moles using this approach.

In this method, the laser beam basically seals the blood vessels and then vaporizes skin tissues. There is no bleeding caused due to the sealing of the blood vessels. The fragmentation of the darker pigments on the skin takes place in this method. These fragments then become lighter on being absorbed by the skin.

To perform laser removal of the mole a local anesthesia is not necessarily needed. It is the doctor who recommends this depending upon the size of the mole. In majority of the cases, there is no anesthesia given. This is because this process does not result in severe pain. It may cause a tingling sensation or the sensation of being snapped by a rubber band.

The laser removal process also has its share of disadvantages along with the benefits that it offers. The major one is its cost. The process of removing a mole falls under the category of cosmetic problems. As a result of this, the expenditure of removing a mole is not covered by the insurance companies and the individual who wishes to get them removed has to pay for it.

There are very little chances of a scar being left by the use of this procedure. It is however important to take adequate post care. Once the treatment is done, a scab develops at the place where the mole used to be located. This area then needs to be protected from the sun for certain weeks. In order to prevent any kind of infection it should also not be scratched.

One of the best options to remove the moles that are located on the face is the laser mole removal. This method is regarded as one of the most effective methods for removing moles. Some of the best things about this method is that it does not cause bleeding and it is not even much painful.
